# IN.723.012.R1 Acupac 30 Instructions For Use

Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 is available in 5 shades: Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 Light, Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 Medium, Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 Characterized Medium, Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 Natural and Acupac 30<sup>®</sup> Plain.

## **INVEST**

Invest and boilout in usual manner. Apply Vitacrilic<sup>®</sup> Bondit<sup>™</sup> Monomer (Item #4451-00) to surface of plastic teeth. Follow Bondit<sup>™</sup> instructions IN.723.015.R0.

### **SEPARATOR**

Apply separator following Vita-Sep<sup>™</sup> (Item #3505-09) instructions.

### **MIXING**

Measure by volume 30cc Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 polymer to 10ml of Acupac<sup>®</sup> 30 minute cure monomer for average denture. (Monomer may be refrigerated for extended working time.) Mix for 15-30 seconds. Cover jar until ready to pack.

#### **PACKING**

Consistency is reached in approximately 5-8 minutes. Pack when material can be pulled from side of mixing jar and is not sticky.

## TRIAL PACKING

Use excess resin on initial pack, close flask slowly with polyethylene sheets between flask halves. Trim excess flash, and then make final closure. (Final Closure sheets, item no. 4010-00)

### **CURING**

Bench set flask in compress for 15 minutes. Put into warm or room temperature water, bring up to full 30 minute boil (212°F / 100°C). Bench cool in usual manner, immerse in cold water. Deflask.

**Caution:** Avoid prolonged handling of uncured mixture and inhalation of monomer vapors. Wear protective gloves when packing resin mixture.
